## GUIDELINES FOR POST HARVEST HANDLING

The present Directive concerns post harvest handling of Nordmann Fir Christmas trees and constitutes the standard of trees delivered to members of The Association of Wholesalers, valid from August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2003.

## **Conditions:**

Cutting The cut must be horizontal

Cutting height Treeheight 80-150 cm: cutting height max 5 cm above ground level

Treeheight 150-250 cm: cutting height max 10 cm above ground level

Length of handle 10 % of tree height

Cleaning of handle Clean, straight, well shaped, no swelling of the root collar

Dragging The trees should not be soiled during dragging

Netting Type of netting by agreement

Hydraulic netting machine min 350 kg pressure

Netting of the smallest possible diameter

Netting must be done in such a manner that the netting will not be removed

during further handling

Milling must be performed lengthways

Palletising Pallet width including boards max 123 cm

Total pallet height max 240 cm

The pallet must be firm and able to withstand loading and reloading

without affecting dimensions or stability

The pallets should not be soiled during transport from the plantation

An agreement must be made concerning size and amount of trees per pallet Each pallet must have a waterproof label showing sizes and amounts of trees

Miscellaneous At dispatch the trees must be clean and free from weeds

Trees with needle loss or discolouration are not to be harvested.

Exceptions from the above Directive must be explicitly mentioned in the contract.
